Cawthorne Children's Centre (CCC) has an account on the popular micro blogging site twitter. Twitter can be a powerful marketing tool e.g. allowing us to let you know about up coming events. It can also be a very quick way to contact you in an emergency e.g. if we have to close The Centre at short notice. In future if twitter proves to be popular in we will set up sub-groups to contact specific groups based on individual rooms. E.g. Butterfly Parents could get messages reminding them their child needs a change of clothes for a specific activity.

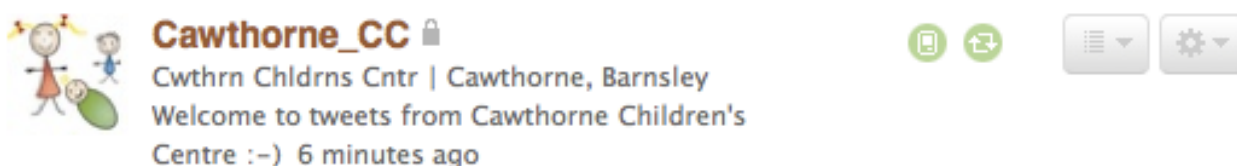
Followers can choose to receive updates via the twitter web portal, email or TXT/SMS. You choose which method suits you. Receiving updates via TXT/SMS is dependent on the technical capabilities of their mobile network carrier. At time of writing Vodafone, O2, Orange and 3 allow updates and tweets via TXT/SMS.

Turning on Text Tweets for Cawthorne Children's Centre, or anyone else You Follow

Once you are following us you can get tweets from Cawthorne Children's Centre via your mobile phone, visit our profile page (Cawthorne_CC), or your following page, and look for the mobile icon (📱). Hover over it. It should be green (🟢). Click the icon to turn tweets off or on. You must be following us first before you can get our updates on your phone.



To turn on following via your mobile send "ON+username" to Twitter, like so:

ON Cawthorne_CC

If you want to turn on tweets by text command if you are not already following CCC, you'll need to send "FOLLOW + username" before sending "ON + username", like so:

FOLLOW Cawthorne_CC

NB your mobile phone must be registered with twitter for this to work!
